POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Operation hours for the pool will be from 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Tennis courts are available on a first come, first serve basis and you must register at the pool entrance prior to going to the tennis courts during the summer season.
- 2. Any person entering the pool area does so at their own risk.
- 3. The Swim and Tennis center is open to all current Yankee Trace residents that are current with their fees. All residents (children and adults) must show their picture ID for entry. A person at the gate will check the resident roster to verify residents and fee status.
- 4. Guests (non-family members) maximum of 5 <u>must be accompanied by resident host or hostess at all times and must show a picture ID for entry.</u> There is a \$4.00 guest fee per person. Permanent summer Nannies will not be charged if registered by owner at sign- in desk. Special exceptions will be considered if requested two weeks in advance at the large pool sign in desk. Examples: Birthday party, Family reunions etc. involving larger number of guests.
- 5. Resident's immediate family & grandchildren may enjoy pool at no charge if parent/grandparent accompanies them, for up to one week per month per registered family member. Visits at either pool counts toward total. If visiting for more than one week a temporary pass for each person may be obtained from the pool manager at the large pool for \$10.00 per person per calendar month. Special unique exceptions will be considered on a case by case basis if requested two weeks in advance.
- 6. No glass containers are allowed in pool area.
- 7. Appropriate swimwear is required. Cut-offs not permitted. Non-potty trained children must wear swim diapers. Please change diapers in the rest room only.
- 8. The Pool Manager and lifeguards are the authority of all activities that take place in the pool and have the authority to ensure patron safety.
- 9. Children age 10 and under must be accompanied by an adult (18 years and older). Parents are required to maintain supervision and discipline of their children at all times. Children 11 and older may attend without an adult. This privilege may be withdrawn by lifeguards due to disorderly conduct.

- 10. No diving is permitted.
- 11. Bicycles, scooters and skateboards are not permitted to be used inside the pool area or parking area. Please park them in the racks provided.
- 12. Flotation aids and other pool toys are allowed at the discretion of the lifeguards according to pool usage and conditions.
- 13. Absolutely no pets are allowed on the pool grounds.
- 14. All accidents should be immediately reported to the Pool Manager or lifeguard on duty.
- 15. The pool may be closed at the discretion of the Pool Manager. In case of inclement weather, there will be a sign posted on the entrance gate.
- 16. The wading pool is for children ages 5 and younger. **Parents are responsible for supervising their children in this pool.**
- 17. Children four years old and younger must be accompanied by an adult in the water while using the main pool.
