Pool Rules and Regulations

- 1. Operation hours for the pool will be from 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM daily from Memorial Day through Labor Day weather permitting. Please be courteous to surrounding neighbors.
- 2. Any person entering the pool does so at their own risk. There are no lifeguards at this pool.
- 3. The pool is available to all current Yankee Trace residents that are current with their fees.
- 4. Family hours will be from 10:00 AM until 1:00 PM daily. All children under 18 years old must be under the direct supervision of an adult 21 years or older. From 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM pool is open to all residents and guest 18 years of age and older.
- 5. Residents must have a pool entrance key card and both adults and children must show a picture I.D. for entrance. A monitor will check a resident roster to verify residency and fee status as you enter.
- 6. Guests (non family members) maximum of 5 <u>must be accompanied by resident host or hostess at all times and must show a picture ID for entry.</u> A \$4.00 guest fee per person applies from 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Special exceptions will be considered if requested at least two weeks in advance at the large pool sign-in desk. Examples: Birthday party, Family reunion etc. may involve a larger number of guests
- 7. Resident's immediate family and grandchildren may enjoy the pool (as noted in the family hours rule 4 above) at no charge if parent/grandparent accompanies them, for up to one week per month per registered individual. Visits at either pool count towards total. If visiting for more than one week a temporary pass for each person may be obtained from the pool monitor at a cost of \$10.00 per person per calendar month. Special unique exceptions will be considered on a case by case basis if requested two weeks in advance.

- 8. No glass containers are allowed in pool area.
- 9. Appropriate swimwear is required. Cut-offs not permitted. Non-potty trained children must wear swim diapers. Please change diapers in the rest rooms only. Since trash is not collected daily take soiled diapers with you when you leave.
- 10. No diving or jumping into the pool is permitted.
- 11. Bicycles are not permitted in the pool area. Use rack provided to park.
- 12. The pool monitor is the authority for all activities that take place at the pool and has the authority to ensure patron safety.
- 13. Music must be kept at a low level.
- 14. Absolutely no pets are allowed in the pool area.
- 15. The pool may be closed at the discretion of the pool monitor. In case of inclement weather a sign will be posted on the front door.

Violation of these rules and regulations may result in a loss of privileges for the remainder of the season.
